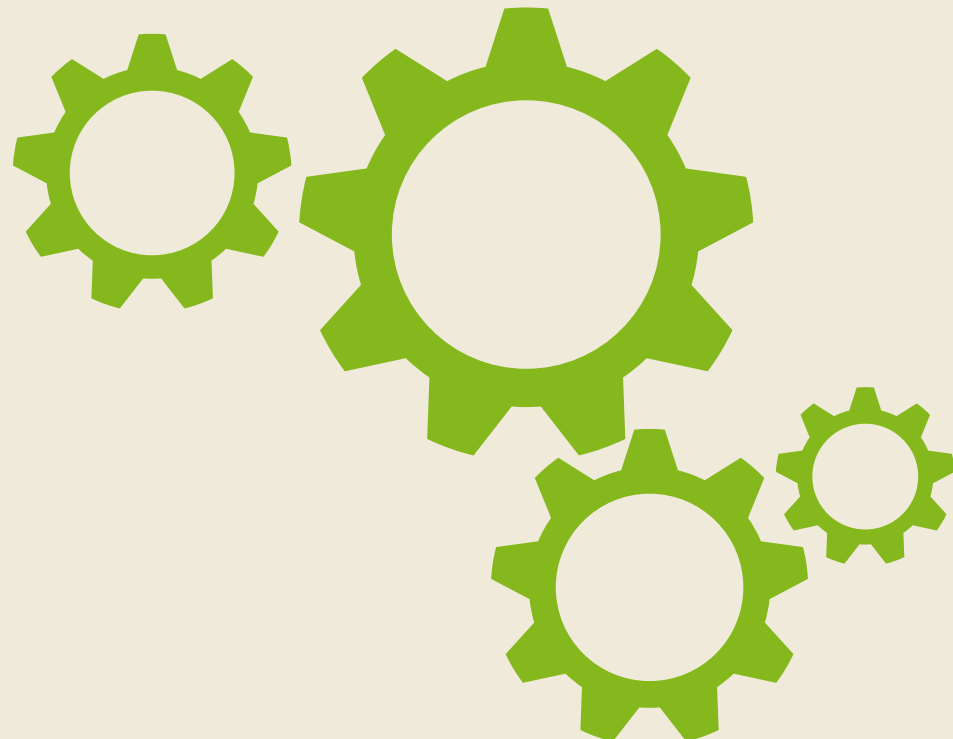

Health insurance

As you can only be enrolled with a health insurance, please contact an insurance company as soon as possible. With a German insurance you can be sure that almost all costs will be covered. The insurance contribution amounts to approximately 90€ per month for students.



Bank account

You can open a bank account at any bank you wish. Student accounts are usually free of charge. When you open a bank account, you will have to present your passport and the bank needs to know where the money in your account will be coming from (parents, stipend, savings, etc.).

The banks, which are close to the campus (Sparkasse and Volksbank) are familiar with the needs of foreign students and when you open your account, be sure to ask for an ATM card. With this card, you can withdraw money from the ATMs of your bank throughout Germany.

Accommodation

The Housing and Social Counseling Department at the International Office offers help and support for international students looking for accommodations. On their page, you will find helpful links for housing in and around Dortmund.



Residence Permit

You have to get in touch with the immigration department assigned to your place of residence within 90 days after your arrival.

Register for classes



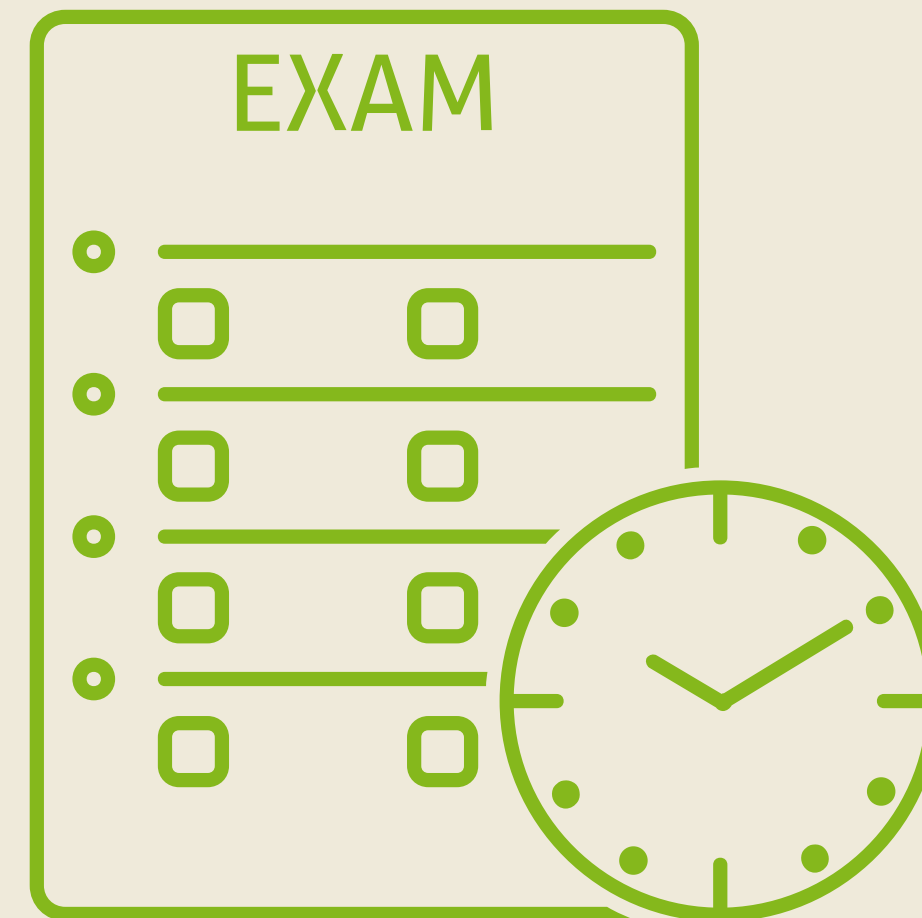

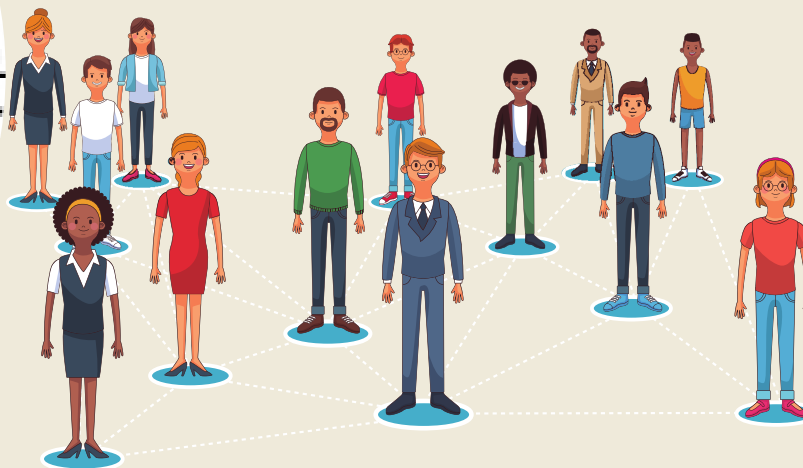

Register for exams

Although you do not have to register for all classes you take, you have to register for the exams. You can register via BOSS until two weeks before the exam.

ERASMUS Students: If you have no access to BOSS it is enough to send an e-mail to the class instructor stating your name, your student number, the name of the class and the exam date. This does not apply to exams to be taken at the Department of Business and Economics. In order to register, please send us an e-mail with all the exam(s) you intend to take at this faculty three weeks prior to the exam(s). If you want to register for exams at the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering, please do so two weeks prior to the exam.
